Acts 20:24 is the scripture that best describes to me the calling for Christian mothers. "But my life is worth nothing to me unless I use it for finishing the work assigned me by the Lord Jesus—the work of telling others the Good News about the wonderful grace of God." (NLT)

I am in the process of writing true short stories for my children and grandchildren in remembrance of some of the ways the Lord has ministered through my husband and I, which led me to think about my own mother in a new and wonderful way.

My mother died when I was 19 after suffering with cancer for the last five years of her life, so I never knew her as an adult. Now, here I am 88 years old and just beginning to "know" her. There is knowing and there is **knowing**.

I knew my mom loved the Lord, after all she took my brother and I to Sunday school every single Sunday. I still have a lovely chain of pins for 10 years of perfect attendance which showed me that she was serious and steadfast about her desire for us to know the Lord. She was a Sunday school teacher to the very young, but she was never my teacher. My mother grew up on a farm and had 18 siblings which included three sets of twins, of which she was one.

Recently, I had occasion to connect with an old Sunday school friend who was five years behind me. It has been over 60 years since I had contact with her, and she told me something really special. She said, "I have wanted to tell you that I am so grateful to your mom.

She was my Sunday school teacher and led me to the Lord as a little girl and changed my whole life." What a precious gift from the Lord! I now could see my mom as an adult.

Why would I share this precious knowledge and gift from the Lord with you? Because I was a Biblical counselor at the Women's Refuge of Vero Beach for close to 25 years and saw many broken women, many of whom were mothers, who needed a place to rest, heal and be restored. I had the privilege of counseling and ministered to many broken women over the years, many of whom were mothers who were able to return to their homes renewed, healed with relationships restored.

The Women's Refuge is a special and unique ministry that the Lord brought into existence over 27 years ago to minister through the Word of God and many other Biblical resources to bring healing

and wholeness to wounded or broken women, many of whom were mothers. Remember the old saying, "If momma ain't right, nothing is right."

I am grateful for the many friends of the Women's Refuge of Vero beach who have sacrificed to make this unique and Biblical ministry happen.


