## WHO WE ARE

A sanctuary where people can start over with a new understanding of God's plan for their lives.

The Women's Refuge, a 501(c)3, was founded in 1997 for people who are experiencing emotional, mental, and spiritual problems. The Refuge offers a Christian live-in program for women, a biblical counseling center for individuals, marriages, and families, and support groups designed to heal the whole person through Christ.

From the beginning, people have found freedom from the debilitation of depression, anxiety, trauma and broken relationships and have gone back to their homes, churches, and communities victorious.

Women residents who have come from around the world have been referred by organizations like Focus on the Family and Mercy Ministries, as well as by pastors, counselors, psychiatrists, families and friends. Physicians, agencies and churches are utilized and coordinated by the Refuge to offer the most effective treatment necessary for each individual.

# MISSION

Our mission of the Women's Refuge of Vero Beach is threefold: to provide a live-in Christian program where hurting women can find sanctuary in a healing environment, to offer biblical counseling and support for the healing and wholeness of emotionally, mentally and spiritually wounded women, men, and families in our community, and to make training available for people to disciple others.

# PURPOSE

Our vision is to instruct and disciple women in a safe environment so that they may learn to live fruitful lives with changed attitudes about themselves, God, and others. We also train leaders to take this same healing message to other ministries and communities. The moment I came on the property I felt God's presence.

#### Community Counseling

"We contacted the Women's Refuge for marital counseling. Our counselor guided us through some very painful memories of our childhood. Learning what God's meaning of forgiveness was, we were able to forgive the people who hurt us in our past. We recognized the childhood hurts we carried into our 47-year marriage, and we needed to forgive each other. That's when the work really began!



I attended the "Conquering Co-Dependency" and the "Shelter from the Storm" support group held at the Refuge. After lots of tears from all the emotions I had bottled up over 50 years, God has healed me from so many painful wounds.

Mark and I learned the definitions, effects, and what the Gospel says about trauma. We learned how to address brokenness and find healing, know God's purpose for marriage, and are working on resolving conflict as well as how to communicate more effectively in our marriage. The most powerful and hardest thing for me to accept was who I am in Christ. I had trust issues and wouldn't confide in anyone. I couldn't even identify what feelings I had because I was too busy trying to survive and raise our family.

What I gained with biblical counseling at the Refuge is I have no secrets from Mark. I trust him more, and he is now the best friend I have always wanted. Mark learned that his severe emotional and physically abusive childhood drove his alcohol and drug addictions for 60 years. He gained freedom in Christ and knows his Heavenly Father loves him. Our marriage is the healthiest it has ever been after a lot of hard work together with the Refuge."


#### Support Group Attendee

"I attended the Women's Refuge in January of 2024. I was depressed, lost, and feeling responsible for all the issues in my life. It was taking a real toll on me and everyone around me. I attended group sessions that will stay with me forever, one of which was the Codependency class. Of course, I had the attitude that I do not have a problem with codependency; boy was I wrong! It truly was the root of all my problems.

What I learned in that class has given me the tools to lead a better and healthier life. It truly was life-changing and life-saving. I refer back to my notes often, as life still has many challenges. Being able to look back on all the material given to me has helped with boundaries and led to healing relationships that I almost destroyed. Boundaries are healthy and necessary. I learned I cannot control anyone or anything, even when I believed it to be with the best intentions. I am beyond grateful to the Refuge for all they do. I lead a much healthier life now, and when struggles come, which they always do, I have the tools to get me through!"

#### Resident Testimony

"I was led to the Women's Refuge in Vero Beach, Florida by the prompting of my sister. I was at a point in my life where I had lost faith in my third marriage and faith in myself. I didn't understand that the pain, anxiety, depression, and anger that were such a familiar part of my life were a result of an unforgiving heart and the need for approval. God led me to the Refuge through a tapestry of circumstances that only He could have



woven together. Immediately I was immersed in one of the most challenging transformative experiences of my life. Through individual counseling, the materials I studied, and the daily guidance I received, God's truth began to resonate and strike a chord in my heart. All my life I had allowed others to dictate my worth, and bent any necessary way in order to gain their approval. In the process, I lost myself. When I began to dig deeply into His Word, God helped me see that I needed to forgive myself, forgive others, and release my past to Him.

There truly is freedom in Christ. I am no longer in bondage to pleasing others to gain my selfworth. My true identity is in Christ; He loves me unconditionally. I can live in abundance and joy, knowing He is always there for me, loving me perfectly and accepting me, despite my circumstances or shortcomings.

I can trust God to guide me and give Him my future. He has worked a miracle in my life. I am now reconciled with my husband. We are still on our journey towards healing as individuals and as a couple. God is rebuilding, refining, and polishing us so that He can be glorified through our testimony."

Lives impacted this past year through our live-in program, biblical counseling, support groups, and training. 76%

Of our financial support comes from individuals like you!

We provide a safe home environment, all meals, biblical counseling, Christ-centered curriculum, teaching materials, group classes, and more. While it costs \$4000 monthly to provide for a resident, their contribution to personal growth is only \$850 per month.

The remaining difference of \$3150 is obtained through individuals, grants, foundations, businesses, organizations, and church support. As shown above, your individual contribution is critical in our efforts to restore lives, allowing them to overcome challenges and thrive with a new awareness of their identity and freedom in Christ.




